RE: COVID-19 Vaccine and Vaccine Administration Codes

On November 10, 2020, the American Medical Association (AMA) announced new procedure codes for the COVID-19 vaccines and vaccine administration. On December 11, 2020, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) issued Emergency Use Authorization for the use of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine.

On December 18, 2020, in accordance with the FDA’s issuance of Emergency Use Authorization for the Moderna COVID-19 vaccine

Cigna STAR+PLUS will cover the administration of the COVID vaccine as non-risk. For vaccines requiring two doses, the Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) anticipates following the Medicare rate methodology. Vendor Drug Program and the HHSC Provider Finance Division continue to research the COVID vaccine administration reimbursement rates.
