

Deactivated NCCI MUE Limitations for Substance Use Disorder Treatment and Breast Pump Replacement Parts

Texas Medicaid has received approval from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) to deactivate the National Correct Coding Initiative (NCCI) Medically Unlikely Edit (MUE) limitation currently in place for the following substance use disorder treatment and breast pump replacement parts procedure codes for dates of service on or after January 1, 2019:

| Procedure Codes | Descriptions |
|----------------------------|--|
| A4281, A4282, A4284, A4286 | Breast pump replacement parts |
| H0005 | Group therapy for substance use disorder treatment |

Effective June 1, 2019, there will no longer be a MUE limiting H0005 to 1 per date of service.

Effective June 1, 2019, breast pump replacement part procedure codes A4281, A4282, A4284, and A4286 may be reimbursed up to a maximum of two of each breast pump replacement part when billed on the same date of service, as appropriate for the typically bilateral nature of the benefit.
